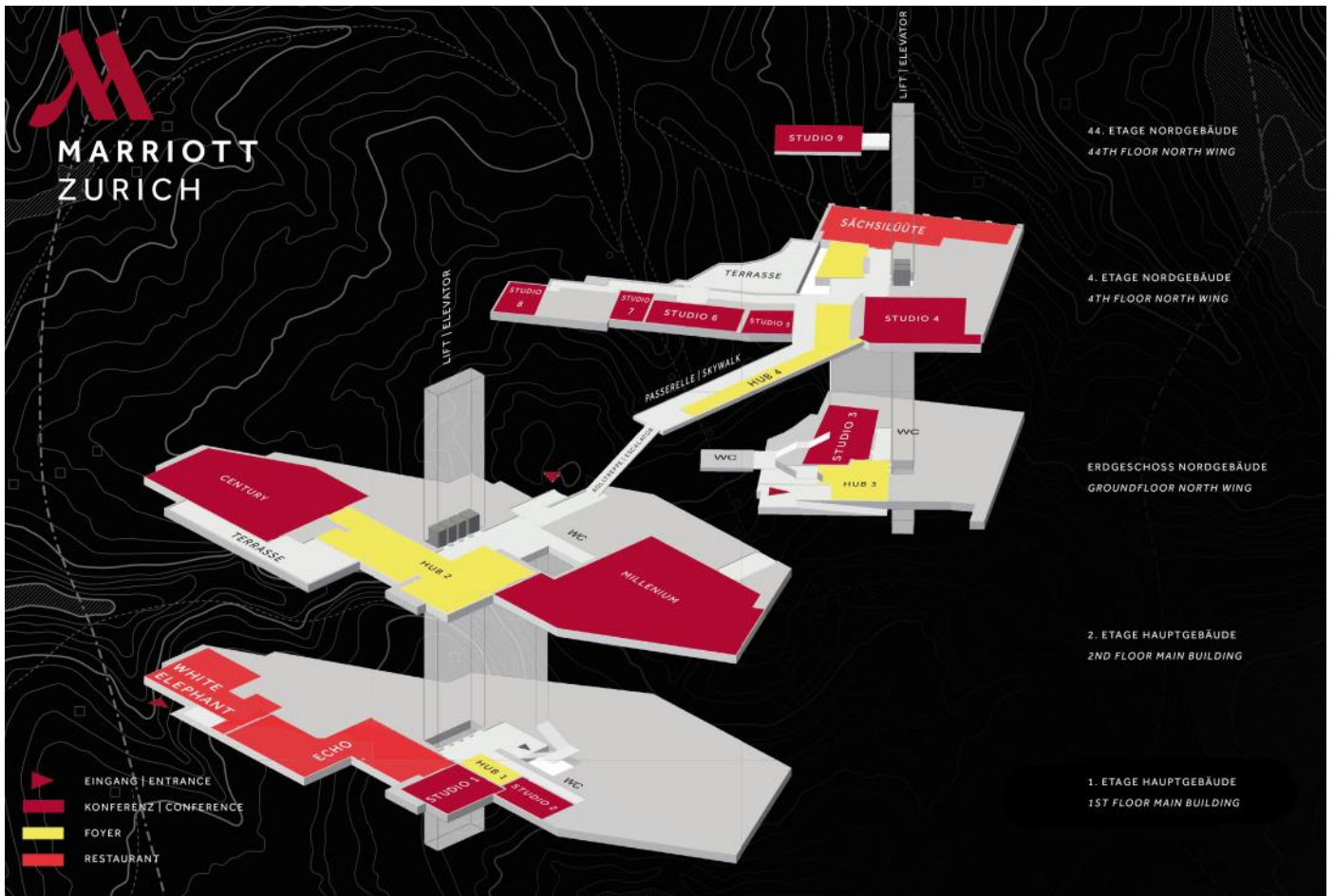

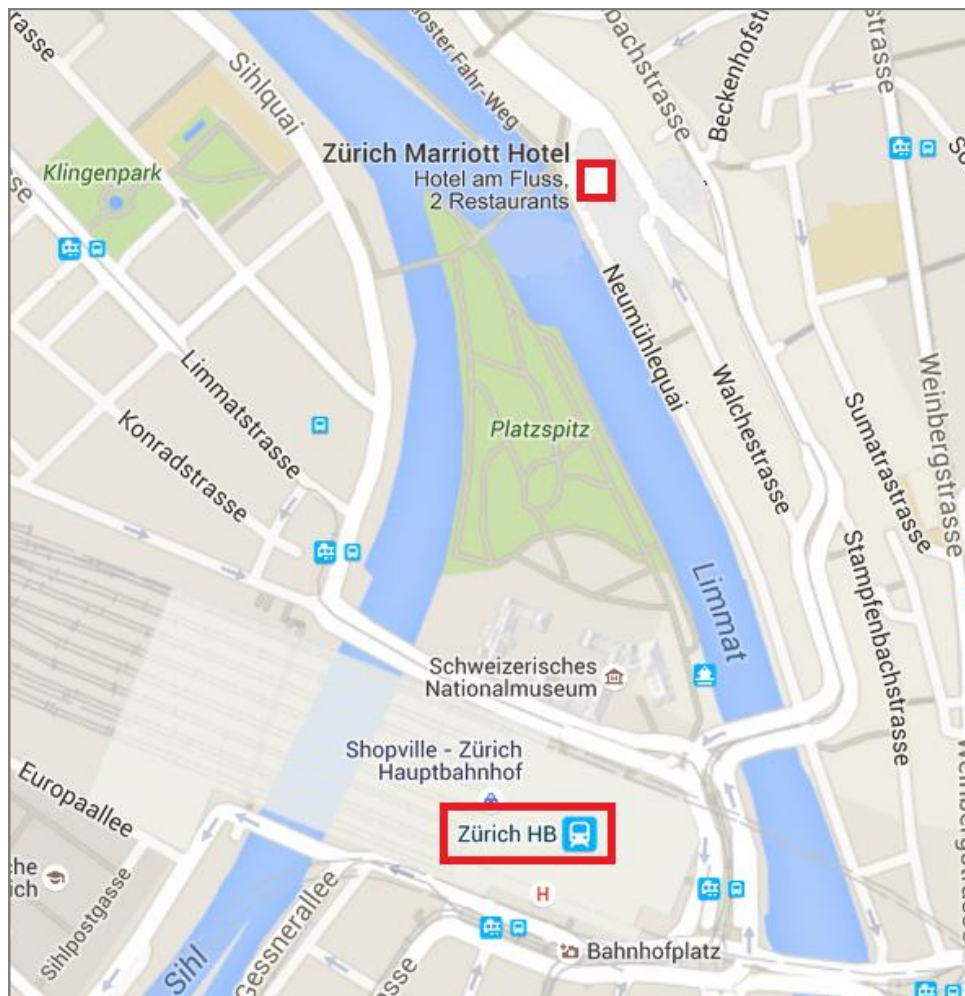
FLOORPLAN & BOOTHS
