Another highlight is the **Symposium on Clinical Cancer Registries in Switzerland** held in collaboration with the National Strategy against Cancer (NSK). This interesting meeting will give you an overview on the existing data collection, the SAKK project "Swiss Real World Data Registry" and an insight in projects and registers in Switzerland.

Furthermore, we would like to draw your attention to the award ceremonies with the **SAKK / Astellas Award**, the **SAKK / Amgen Grant**, the **SAKK / Celgene Life Grant** and the **GIST Award**, taking place on Thursday from 1 – 2 pm.
