After the previous success, the Swiss Group for Clinical Cancer Research (SAKK) and Novartis Pharma Schweiz AG will again award the SAKK/Novartis Together for Patients Award. This Award supports planned and ongoing patient-focused projects in the field of Hemato-Oncology and Oncology. Hemato-oncological projects are especially encouraged to apply.

- Application deadline is September 30, 2021



Application Process and Timelines

Applications have to be submitted electronically via the SAKK website until September 30, 2021.

You

- Are an individual health care professional or group working in the health sector (practicing doctors, health care representatives, nurses, etc.)
- Have your primary place of work in Switzerland (hospital, private practice, other institution)
- Must finance your project via an institutional bank account

Your project

- Aims to prevent hemato-oncological and oncological diseases and/or,
- Reduces the disease burden on patients and/or their families and/or,
- Improves patient care by optimizing prevention, networking, care, education, communication, outcome, and quality of life

Grant winner

An independent jury, chaired by the SAKK board member Prof. Dr. med. Miklos Pless, evaluates all projects and announces the grant winner at the Swiss Oncology and Hematology Congress (SOHC) in November 2021, where he/she will be requested to present a short exposé on the planned project. Further notifications about the winning project will be published in the Schweizer Krebsbulletin, the SAKK newsletter and on the SAKK website.
